Official Rules & Regulations

Course Rules & Regulations

General Regulations & Course Authority

- The opening and closing of the golfing season are at the discretion of management.
- Course staff and marshals are authorized to enforce all rules.
- Failure to comply may result in loss of playing privileges.
- Personal property brought onto course property is at the sole risk of the owner. The Club is not responsible for loss or damage.
- All members and guests must observe posted signage, including temporary restrictions and safety notices.
- Smoking is permitted only in designated areas.
- Members and guests may not use facilities when the course is closed unless approved by management.
- No pets are allowed on the golf course.
- Management reserves the right to refuse play or service.

Tee Times, Bookings & Play

- All players must register in the Pro Shop prior to playing.
- Play must begin at the scheduled tee time.
- Tee-time availability is not guaranteed.
- Singles and twosomes will be paired to maximize course access.
- Maximum group size is four players.
- All player names must be recorded when reserving tee times. Incomplete groups will be filled.
- To ensure fair access for all members, we ask that tee times be cancelled or updated within the required notice period. Failure to do so may result in the following:
 - **First occurrence:** Verbal reminder
 - **Second occurrence:** One (1) week suspension of membership privileges
 - **Third occurrence:** One (1) month suspension of membership privileges
 - **Fourth occurrence:** Membership privileges revoked for the remainder of the season
- Starting on the 10th tee is not permitted without Pro Shop approval.
- Play before scheduled tee times is not permitted.
- Maintenance staff always have priority on the course.

Pace of Play

- Maintain pace with the group ahead.
- Ready golf is encouraged when safe.
- Allow faster groups to play through when appropriate.
- Groups falling behind may be asked to skip a hole to regain pace.

Official Rules & Regulations

- Target pace of play: 9 holes approximately 2 hours; 18 holes approximately 4–4.5 hours.

Turf Care Regulations

- Replace divots and repair ball marks on greens.
- Rake sand traps after use.
- Use care with flagsticks and avoid turf damage during practice swings.
- Keep power carts at least 30 feet from greens and use cart paths rough when possible.
- Bug spray must not be applied on turf, tees, or greens as it causes damage.
- Respect course property and fellow players.

Golf Carts & Walking

- All power carts must be returned to the Pro Shop before dusk.
- Follow all cart path signage and daily cart rules.
- Reckless cart operation is prohibited.
- Members and guests are responsible for any damage to power carts.
- Power cart use may be restricted due to weather or course conditions at the discretion of management.
- No more than two power carts are permitted per group.

Dress Code

- Golf-appropriate attire is required.
- Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times.
- Shorts or skirts must be of appropriate length.
- Soft-spike golf shoes only.
- Clothing with offensive language or graphics is not permitted.

Safety

- Do not hit until the group ahead is safely out of range.
- In the event of lightning or severe weather, follow course warning signals and staff instructions.
- Management reserves the right to suspend play for safety reasons.

Alcohol & Conduct

- Alcoholic beverages must be purchased on site.
- Outside alcohol and coolers are strictly prohibited. The Club reserves the right to restrict play if alcohol is brought onto the property.
- Music is permitted at low volume and must not disturb others.
- Any person found damaging course property or equipment may have golf privileges suspended immediately.

Junior & Family Rules

- Juniors under 12 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
- Juniors must maintain pace of play and follow all course rules.

Official Rules & Regulations

- Children not playing golf must be supervised at all times.
- Juniors may not operate power carts unless licensed and approved.

Membership Power Cart Package

- Membership includes one seat on a power cart. The Club may assign another approved rider.
- Single riders may be required to pay the full cart fee.
- Two power carts with single riders will not be issued.
- A maximum of two power carts is permitted per group.
- Power carts are not guaranteed despite purchasing a cart package.
- Cart packages apply to Club tournaments only; outside events require cart rental.

Membership Guidelines

- Proof of age may be required at the time of membership purchase.
- Memberships are non-refundable and non-transferable.
- Management reserves the right to revoke memberships for conduct detrimental to the Club.
- Individual Age 31+: Seven-day play during available tee times.
- Individual Weekday: Monday–Friday play only.
- Out-of-County Individual: Seven-day play during available tee times.
- Intermediate (19–30): Seven-day play; must not reach age 31 before April 1.
- Junior Member: Seven-day play; must not reach age 19 before April 1.
- Family Membership: 2 Adult Memberships and 2 Junior Memberships.
- Ladies Social League: Play restricted to Ladies Day, Ladies Night, and Sundays after 1pm.
- 9-Hole Membership: One 9-hole round per day; additional holes subject to fees.
- Dual Membership allows play at both partner courses and eligibility for Club Championships.
- Memberships with Cart Package do not guarantee power cart availability.
